MOTION

On June 1st, 2022, Council adopted CF21-1131 which instructed the Department of Transportation to initiate a feasibility study to analyze the implementation of a pilot program to close down blocks in Downtown Los Angeles for pedestrians and bicyclists only. One of the blocks identified was Broadway between 3rd Street and 4th Street, adjacent to Grand Central Market. While the Department is analyzing a long term closure of the street, Council District 14 seeks to pilot closures of this block of Broadway through *Summerfest on Broadway*.


Summerfest will temporarily close Broadway between 3rd Street and 4th Street for four consecutive weekends beginning the weekend of August 25th-27th and will feature vendors and entertainment for the general public. CD14 has partnered with the Downtown Center Business Improvement District (DCBID) to provide entertainment and other amenities related to the temporary closure of the street. The DCBID is in need of funding in order to implement this event and sufficient funds are available for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Clerk to transfer \$57,000 from AB1290 Fund No. 53P, Account No. 281214 (CD 14 Redevelopment Projects - Services) to the Business Improvement District (BID) Trust Fund No. 659, Account No. 400 (Downtown Center BID) for expenses related to the production of Summerfest on Broadway.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Clerk to disburse funds to the DCBID consistent with the intent of this motion.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council authorize the City Clerk to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically, or by any other means.
