RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the City Council reaffirm its findings of March 28, 2018, that it has imposed all the mitigation measures that are within the control of the City, as described in the Final Environmental Impact Report (State Clearinghouse No. 2005061007) that are associated with the impacts of the street vacation and that other mitigation measures that are not within the authority of the City, have been or should be imposed as set forth in the findings of the Board of Education of the City of Los Angeles, dated June 26, 2007.
2. That the City Council reaffirm its finding of March 28, 2018, that this vacation is in substantial conformance with the General Plan pursuant to Section 556 of the City Charter.
3. That the Resolution to Vacate No. 23-1401019 for this vacation be adopted.

DISCUSSION:

Resolution to Vacate: At the meeting of the City Council on March 28, 2018, no protests were filed against this vacation. The Resolution to Vacate is being presented pursuant to Council instructions of March 28, 2018.

Resolution to Vacate No. 23-1401019 has been approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
