**DRAFT ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION  
ON TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE  
VOTERS OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES A CERTIFIED INITIATIVE ORDINANCE  
REGARDING A MINIMUM WAGE FOR EMPLOYEES WORKING AT CERTAIN  
HEALTHCARE FACILITIES, AND CONSOLIDATING THIS SPECIAL ELECTION  
WITH THE CITY'S PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION AND THE STATE PRIMARY  
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE**

Honorable Members:

The enclosed draft ordinance formally calls a special election for one of the four citizen-sponsored initiatives that the City Council has ordered be placed on the March 2024 ballot.

On June 10, 2022, the City Clerk presented the City Council with a certified initiative petition in support of a proposed ordinance regarding a minimum wage for employees working at certain healthcare facilities. On June 21 and 29, 2022, the City Council took action to adopt the initiative ordinance directly, as authorized in City Charter Section 452(a). The ordinance was signed by the Mayor and assigned Ordinance No. 187566. Opponents of the ordinance thereafter circulated and filed a referendum petition against the ordinance, and the City Clerk certified the referendum petition as sufficient, forcing a vote on Ordinance No. 187566. On September 30, 2022, the City Council adopted a resolution, pursuant to Charter Sections 452 and 462,

directing that Ordinance No. 187566 be submitted to the voters at the City's regularly scheduled election to be held on March 5, 2024 (Council File No. 22-1100-S4).

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance formally calling a Special Election on Ordinance No. 187566 to be held on March 5, 2024. The draft ordinance contains a ballot title and question for the measure. The draft ordinance also authorizes consolidation of the Special Election with the City's Primary Nominating Election and the State's Primary Election to be held on the same date and conducted by the County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk. We have approved the enclosed draft ordinance as to form and legality.
