Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker - Padilla):

REQUEST the Port of Los Angeles (POLA) report to the Trade, Travel and Tourism Committee and Public Safety Committee how the Port will ensure that terminal operators/tenants comply with the Presidential Executive Order of February 21, 2024; how the Port will coordinate with the U.S. Coast Guard to ensure security; and how the Port, and the City, can actively promote the goal of development of U.S. manufacturing of cranes.

At the meeting held on March 15, 2024, your Government Operations Committee considered an Motion (McOsker - Padilla) relative to addressing maritime cyber threats and related matters.
