

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to developing a program evaluation framework in connection with existing and future homeless program contracts.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez – Raman):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Housing Department, with the assistance of City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to:

- a. Develop a program evaluation framework that can be incorporated into any existing and future homeless program contracts between the City and Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority and its sub-contractors or between the City and any other contractor, with options of hiring a third party evaluator, and to report to Council in 90 days with recommendations.
- b. Include in the program evaluation framework monitoring of program expenditures, underspending, key performance indicators, program benchmarks and reporting schedules.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY
