Comments for Public Posting: On March 19, 2014, the Los Angeles City Council unanimously adopted the motion by Councilmember Mike Bonin in 13-1625, (1) recognizing that Pacific Palisades Community Council, founded in 1973, is the council for the community of Pacific Palisades that pre-dates the Neighborhood Council system and that its role is “identical to that of a certified neighborhood council”; and (2) instructing City Planning to notify Pacific Palisades Community Council of all planning issues on the same basis and in the same manner as the City’s certified neighborhood councils. Since the Council’s action in CF 13-1625, Pacific Palisades Community Council has received notifications from City Planning in the same manner and on the same basis as certified neighborhood councils. We therefore respectfully request that Pacific Palisades Community Council continue to receive the same notifications from City Planning that it is entitled to receive under the adopted motion in CF 13-1625, including all notifications required to be provided to certified neighborhood councils under the proposed “Processes and Procedures” Ordinance (CF 12-0460-S4).
