


MOTION

On February 20, 2024, the City temporarily closed a segment of Benedict Canyon Drive due to a washout from the recent heavy rains that undermined the roadway. There is an emergency need to restore lateral support, install a bulkhead structure, and reconstruct the roadway. The Bureau of Engineering anticipates issuing an emergency bid to undertake the work, at an estimated cost of \$879,000. Approval by the City Council and Mayor is required to establish new capital projects and to appropriate funds.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, subject to approval of the Mayor, establish a new capital project entitled "2940 Benedict Canyon Drive February 2024 Storm Response," and within the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Trust Fund 59V-50, appropriate \$879,000 from Available Cash Balance to a new account entitled "2940 Benedict Canyon Drive February 2024 Storm Response."

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Administrative Officer be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers.
