

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to all current contracts with Los Angeles (LA) River maintenance activities.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman, Hernandez, Padilla – Soto-Martínez):

INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with assistance from the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Department of Public Works, Los Angeles Department of Transportation, Department of Recreation and Parks, Bureau of Sanitation, and all other relevant agencies, to report within 60 days, with a report listing all current contracts (including their fees and term lengths), staff positions and costs, and other direct and indirect costs associated with Los Angeles River maintenance activities. The report should indicate contracts and services that could be performed by the LA River Rangers, and recommendations how the LA River Rangers could take over said contracts and services. The report should also indicate full time and part time staff resources needed as well as any potential new contracts needed to holistically manage the daily maintenance needs of the LA River Way, LA River Greenway, river parks, or other City-maintained areas along the LA River.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted
