

GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the success of Logistics Victory Los Angeles (LoVLA) and lessons learned that could enhance procurement of critical supplies and materials.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Padilla):

INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Department of General Services, the Office of Procurement, and the Port of Los Angeles, report on the success of LoVLA and any lessons learned that could enhance the procurement of critical supplies and materials, not only during a declared local emergency, but on a daily basis for the departments in the City of Los Angeles.
