



Comments of the call read, "SEE PR WILL DIRECT TO SUSP IN ROOM B18 - SUSP "BOBBY" M/B 35YRS WHITE SHIRT, BLK SHORTS ARMED W/ A KNIFE. R/O ON FILE. SUSP ASSAULTED EMPLOYEE AT LOC W/ HANDS AND THREATENED THEM W/ KNIFE".

Incident #22070700000287

We received a second radio call, "ADW suspect there now". Comments of the call read, "SUSP M/B WRNG BLK SWEATER, BLK SHIRT, RED SHOES ARMED WITH KNIFE. SUSP HIT HOTEL EMPLOYEE".

Investigation:

As my partner and I initially arrived at scene (Inc. 22070700000185) we met with the P/A- Molina, Miguel who stated that he had been physically assaulted by the Deft (later identified as Jackson, Bobby). The P/A stated that as he was sweeping the bottom floor of the motel he was approached by the Deft. The Deft then punched the P/A approximately six times in the face. The Deft then exit the gate into the parking lot of the motel and left the location. The Deft then immediately returned and spit on the P/A's face. The Deft then fled in an unknown direction.

The P/A further stated that the Deft frequently shows up to the Motel and demands a key to a room. The P/A stated that the Deft is sometimes seen carrying a black knife. The Deft on many occasions enters the motel property and claims he is staying there.

I then spoke to Wit- Leyva, Gilberto who stated that as he was inside of the office watching the surveillance cameras he observed the Deft approach the P/A and punch him multiple times. The Deft then quickly walked out to the parking lot and left the location. The Wit then called police.

At approximately 0210 hours, we received a second radio call (Inc. 22070700000287) at the same location matching the same Susp description as the initial radio call. As my partner and I arrived at scene we observed the Deft matching the Susp description of the radio call standing inside of the motel property behind the gate. My partner and I gave the deft commands to exit the gate. The Deft then retrieved a black pocket knife from his front right pants pocket. The Deft opened the pocket knife and held it in his right hand. My partner and I gave the Deft commands to drop the knife. The Deft then placed the knife in his front sweater pocket and exit the gate. My partner and I continued to give the Deft commands and eventually took the Deft into custody without further incident.

I spoke to the P/A who stated that the Deft returned to the location and demanded room keys. The P/A

8. There is a reasonable likelihood that the offense or offenses will continue or resume, or that the safety of persons or property will be imminently endangered by release of the person arrested.			
9. The person arrested demands to be taken before a magistrate or refused to sign the notice to appear.			
10. There is reason to believe that the person arrested would not appear at the time/place specified in the notice.
