

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE, and RESOLUTION (BLUMENFIELD – HUTT) relative to posting “No Stopping Anytime” signs on the west side of Canoga Avenue between Keswick Street and Saticoy Street.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Blumenfield – Hutt):

RESOLVE to, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507(a), INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to post “No Stopping Anytime” signs on the west side of Canoga Avenue between Keswick Street and Saticoy Street, to address criminal activity associated with parked vehicles along this street segment.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On December 4, 2024, your Transportation Committee considered an October 9, 2024 Resolution (Blumenfield – Hutt) relative to posting “No Stopping Anytime” signs on the west side of Canoga Avenue between Keswick Street and Saticoy Street. According to the Resolution, the Los Angeles Police Department has identified a long-standing issue with criminal activity along a segment of Canoga Avenue and vehicles parked at this location appear to be a contributing factor to the situation, and is requesting the LADOT to prohibit parking in the immediate vicinity with the installation of “No Stopping Anytime” signs. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommendation to approve the Resolution failed. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
