Comments for Public Posting: This report suggests that the cost of implementing the Mobility Plan 2035 may include repaving costs, but the City already repaves hundreds of miles of streets per year, and this routine maintenance work is already budgeted for. The estimate of implementing the Mobility Plan 2035 without taking into account repaving costs is approximately \$2 Billion LESS. Whether it's the City's version of Healthy Streets LA or Healthy Streets LA, both only trigger when repaving is done. Therefore, the cost of repaving should be excluded, since it's budgeted for separately.
