## **BUREAU OF ENGINEERING FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 PROPOSED BUDGET**

Dear Chair Yaroslavsky and Honorable Members:

The Bureau of Engineering (Engineering) appreciates the opportunity to provide input on the 2025-26 Proposed Budget and the Council's spirit of collaboration in addressing the City's fiscal crisis while mitigating impacts on the workforce, capital project delivery, and city services. We recognize the serious situation the City's budget is in and stand ready to work with your committee to avert layoffs.

Engineering is the City's primary project delivery organization for non-proprietary capital projects, with a mission and organization-wide commitment to be a national leader in the delivery of sustainable capital projects. Engineering annually delivers a diverse set of wastewater, municipal, and recreation and park facilities, as well as bridge and street improvements, streetscapes, and stormwater system projects. Engineering supports business and economic development through permitting and regulation of activity in the public right-of-way. Through effective project delivery and responsive permitting, Engineering advances the City's sustainability, resilience, and recovery goals.

In the past 24 hours, Engineering has identified key impacts from the 131 proposed position cuts and begun developing solutions to mitigate layoffs. Of the 131 positions proposed for elimination, 91 are currently filled. The proposed cuts are reflected in the attached organizational chart. We have also provided graphs of the proposed cuts by division and by classification group.

Fortunately, the Proposed Budget retains a number of special-funded vacancies that is approximately equal to the number of filled positions proposed for elimination. We look forward to presenting a budget-neutral combination of cuts and offsets at next week's hearing that will restore key positions and classifications to avoid layoffs and minimize impacts, as previewed below.

Given the severity of the cuts, service impacts and capital project delays are inevitable. By focusing on our workforce, we are prioritizing the long-term effectiveness of the organization. Not

only do layoffs impact the affected employee and overall morale, every layoff means losing a skilled and experienced employee that the City has invested in. It takes years to rebuild and retrain a skilled workforce, so short-term measures to protect employees now will pay dividends for long-term service delivery.

### Strategies to Mitigate Budget Cuts

Engineering has identified the following key approaches to mitigate the severity of the proposed budget cuts:

#### *1. Transition employees from General Fund positions into Special Fund positions by July 1*

As mentioned previously, the Proposed Budget retains a number of special-funded vacancies that is approximately equal to the number of filled positions proposed for elimination. To avoid layoffs, Engineering proposes to move employees from eliminated positions into these vacant special-funded positions.

Within Engineering's \$5 billion capital program, projects are funded by dozens of different funding sources. This strategy will generally transfer employees from projects funded by the General Fund and impacted Special Funds to projects that are funded by less constrained funding sources. This will result in delays or deferrals for those projects that staff is pulled from and those delays will likely increase project costs down the road, however this is a better option compared to layoffs of skilled project managers and design staff. Engineering will identify special-funded or grant-funded projects that can absorb staff. In some cases, it may be possible to accelerate grant-funded projects with the reallocated staff.

Engineering will provide a list of proposed adjustments to the position cuts needed to implement this strategy. Engineering also requests exemptions from Priority Critical Hiring for these personnel actions in order to implement them prior to July 1. In order to avoid layoffs, some positions may need to be added or restored (with offsets) to address misalignments between classification groups.

#### *2. Restore selected positions using 4-month transition funding as offset*

The Proposed Budget includes funding for four months of salaries for filled positions proposed for layoff. By beginning the transfer of employees from General Fund positions on or before July 1st, as proposed under Strategy 1 above, this salary funding can instead be used to selectively restore some critical positions proposed for elimination. Engineering will provide a list of positions proposed for restoration using this offset at next week's hearing.

#### *3. In-source consultant work to City staff*

Engineering performs a variety of professional services for client departments. We will work with our capital project delivery divisions and client departments to identify funded work that would otherwise be performed by consultants that could instead be performed by Engineering staff, such as survey, architectural and engineering services, and project management. We have already identified opportunities to support delivery of LADWP projects and are exploring additional opportunities with other proprietary departments. We also request your committee's assistance in identifying additional opportunities to in-source work to our technical staff as you deliberate other City departments' budgets.

*4. Adjust permit fees to improve cost recovery and mitigate permit staff reductions*

Since the last increase in 2016, permit fees have not kept up with inflation and cost increases. While current fee levels do pay for direct salary expenses, they do not fully cover overhead and related costs. Engineering has proposed a fee adjustment for various permit fees to achieve nearly full cost recovery in the Development Services Program. The current fee study supports raising fees by up to \$7.5 million next fiscal year, which is more than enough to offset the \$3.2 million cost of restoring the 30 position cuts in Development Services. By reducing General Fund subsidy, the additional revenue raised can offset other cuts to Engineering as well.

Additionally, BuildLA requires a sustainable funding solution to pay for operations and maintenance. An existing surcharge on permit fees could be extended to provide ongoing funding. Engineering also recommends revisiting the potential eligibility of this surcharge for City staff salaries.

In closing, I want to thank the dedicated Engineering employees who work hard to serve the residents of our City despite the extraordinary challenges we are facing. Our employees stepped up in the wake of the greatest natural disaster in the City's history to protect public health and safety and accelerate recovery and rebuilding. This year's emergency underscores the value and importance of having a skilled and capable workforce to respond to unforeseen and unimaginable events, on top of the critical services our employees perform every day.




Figure 2: Proposed cuts by classification group


