

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Brandy Menard, et al., v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCV14878. (This matter arises from an automobile versus motorcycle accident that occurred on June 7, 2020, at the intersection of 6th Avenue and West Martin Luther King Boulevard, in the city of Los Angeles.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney's Office to expend up to **\$195,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to place on the agenda for the first regular Council meeting on July 1, 2025, or shortly thereafter, the following instruction:
 - a. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer **\$195,000** from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009797, Transportation Liability Payouts.
 - b. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw two demands from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009797, Transportation Liability Payouts, as follows:
 - i. **\$118,443.81** to Douglas / Hicks Law, APC Trust Account.
 - ii. **\$76,556.19** to Pacific Life & Annuity Services Inc. FBO Brian Menard (to fund future periodic payments in relation to the structured settlement).
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Yaroslavsky – Blumenfield – Hutt – McOsker – Hernandez: "Yes") at its meeting held on June 3, 2025, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
