

NEIGHBORHOODS AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 53.06.01 to increase the limit of household dogs from three to four in the City.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST the City Attorney to draft an ordinance amending the LAMC Section 53.06.01 to increase the limit of household dogs from three to four in the City.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Department of Animal Services reports that increasing the household limit of dogs in the City may result in some positive impacts to future revenues from the collection of licensing fees for dogs.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On October 23, 2024, your Committee considered the October 9, 2024 Department of Animal Services report relative to amending the LAMC to increase the limit of household dogs from three to four in the City. The report attached to the Council file includes some background on the matter.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
