REPORT relative to the feasibility and implementation of a requirement to microchip all dogs, cats, rabbits, and horses.

Recommendation for Council action:

DIRECT the Department of Animal Services, in collaboration with the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Personnel Department, to report with a proposed one-year pilot program to expand microchip education, administration, and implantation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
