**DISCUSSION**

This donation will provide one commercial lawn mower to maintain the Emergency Vehicle Operations Center (EVOC) track at the Davis Training Facility. The mower previously assigned to the Facility was salvaged without replacement, and the City's Department of Recreation and Parks stopped maintaining the EVOC track since 2019. Approval of this donation will control brush overgrowth, ensure officer safety, and allow fire safety regulations to be met.

**SUBJECT:** LOS ANGELES POLICE FOUNDATION GRANT REQUEST

The Emergency Vehicle Operations Center (EVOC) was tasked with locating and presenting options for a replacement commercial mower. The mower that was assigned to the Davis Training Facility to maintain the EVOC track was salvaged by Motor Transport Division without a replacement.

The mower is needed to control brush overgrowth and meet fire safety regulations. Without it, officer safety and training are compromised, as dense foliage makes it difficult for Recruit Officers to see hazards and for instructors to monitor performance. The City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks maintained the EVOC track until 2019 but no longer maintains the Davis Training Facility.

The grant will be used to purchase a commercial mower suited to the Davis Training Facility's rough terrain. The selected mower includes accessories and on-site training for the Gardener Caretaker, who is qualified to operate various mowers. We are requesting \$54,152.74, with the cost breakdown attached. Since the Motor Transport Division will not service the mower, the invoice includes a service plan and warranty based on hourly usage.
