In its first year, already ULA has: - Kept 11,000 Angelenos housed through its Short-Term Emergency Assistance (emergency rental assistance) program; - Funded 795 new affordable homes currently under development; - Created 10,000 new union construction jobs responsible for building the affordable housing; - Resourced Stay Housed LA to continue and expand its work to provide eviction prevention and defense services and tenant outreach and education to thousands of tenants each year. - ...and more!
