

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an implementation plan for the recommended Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 improvements outlined in the LA 2028 Legacy Streets Improvements Plan.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (De León – Lee):

1. DIRECT the Department of Public Works (DPW) to report within 90 calendar days with an implementation plan for the recommended Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 improvements outlined in the LA 2028 Legacy Streets Improvements Plan with said report to: a. Identify Tier 1 and Tier 2 improvements such as tree planting, sidewalk repair, bus shelters, and street lighting repair that can be folded into the city's annual work programs in order to complete the improvements by 2028. b. Identify which Tier 3 improvements would be competitive for grant funding and include a time line for applying for these funds in its report.
2. DIRECT the Bureau of Street Services (BOSS) in coordination with the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, Bureau of Engineering, City Administrative Officer (CAO) and other entities as necessary to report within 45 days with a cost estimate, work plan, and timeline for conducting the 2028 Legacy Street Improvement Plan for the areas in and around UCLA and other Olympic/Paralympic venues with focus on pedestrians and bicycle infrastructure in connection with providing first/last mile connections to the transit system.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On November 1, 2023, your Committee considered a Motion (De León – Lee) relative to an implementation plan for the recommended Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 improvements outlined in the LA 2028 Legacy Streets Improvements Plan. According to the Motion, in 2028, the City will host the Olympic Games for the third time in its history. As a City, we want to put our best foot forward by ensuring that the Los Angeles of summer 2028 reflects the world-class city we know LA can be. Thanks to the investments the City made for and since the 1984 games, the City is well-prepared in terms of venues, housing for the athletes, and lodging for tourists. However, as outlined in the LA 2028 Legacy Streets Improvements Plan (Council File No. 20-1004), additional investments in the streets and sidewalks in the neighborhoods surrounding the Olympic venues are necessary. The BOSS identified Tier 1, 2, and 3 investments that require a varying level of effort to

implement. The city should invest the resources necessary in order to implement the Bureau's plan. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion, as amended. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
