## DISCUSSION

This donation will provide restroom improvements at 77<sup>th</sup> Street Station. Approval of this donation will repair the restrooms which lack proper drainage and need mold abatement behind the wall and floor tiles. Also, the countertops need repairs as they were initially constructed of inferior materials and absorb rather than repel water. They will no longer pose a health hazard and be much easier for the custodian to keep sanitary. Below is a list of items to be donated, along with their estimated value.



**NAME OF REQUEST: Restroom Improvements**

It is requested that 77<sup>th</sup> Street Area be approved for improving the restrooms at 77<sup>th</sup> Street Station from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, valued at \$114,705. Approval of this donation benefits the Department as follows:

The restrooms in the 77<sup>th</sup> Street Station have needed repairs for a long time. As indicated by the city engineer, they lack proper drainage and need mold abatement behind the wall and floor tiles. Also, the countertops need repair as they were initially constructed of inferior materials and absorb rather than repel water. Once repaired, the shower area in the men's restroom and the countertops in the restrooms will be in good working order and last significantly longer than the originals. Also, they will no longer pose a health hazard and be much easier for the custodians to keep sanitary.

Seventy-Seventh Street Area is one of the largest patrol commands in the Department, housing over 300 officers and detectives. The restrooms are constantly used, and their condition has impacted morale. This grant will improve the station and prevent officers from showering in standing water surrounded by mold.
