

TRADE, TRAVEL AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to ensure the Living Wage Ordinance is in compliance with the recent Ninth Circuit Court decision, Airlines for America v. City and County of San Francisco, 78 F.4th 1146 (9th Cir. 2023).

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE, dated December 6, 2023, amending Section 10.37 of the LAAC to ensure the Living Wage Ordinance is in compliance with the recent Ninth Circuit Court decision, Airlines for America v. City And County of San Francisco, 78 F.4th 1146 (9th Cir. 2023).

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on January 16, 2024, your Trade, Travel and Tourism Committee considered a City Attorney report and draft Ordinance relative to amending the LAAC to ensure the Living Wage Ordinance is in compliance with the recent Ninth Circuit Court decision, Airlines for America v. City and County of San Francisco, 78 F.4th 1146 (9th Cir. 2023). Subsection (g)(3) of Section 10.37.6 of the LAAC is deleted in its entirety and the remaining Subsection (g)(4) is renumbered as Subsection (g)(3). A copy of the draft Ordinance was sent, pursuant to Council Rule 38, to the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Contract Administration with a request that all comments, if any, be presented directly to the City Council when this matter is considered.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the City Attorney report and draft Ordinance dated December 6, 2023, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for consideration.
