

CIVIL RIGHTS, EQUITY, IMMIGRATION AGING AND DISABILITY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to reprogramming Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds included in the Program Year 50 Consolidated Plan, from the LA BusinessSource Program line item, to the Sacred Grounds Business Relocation Project.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (McOsker - Hutt):

- 1. INSTRUCT the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD) to initiate a legacy business grant of \$30,000 with the Sacred Grounds coffee shop to assist with their business enterprise.
- 2. INSTRUCT the EWDD to immediately confer with the owners of the business to complete the necessary application and contract documents.
