Therefore, we believe it is important for the Guatemalan community to have its own recognition, similar to other cultures in the city. This support is in conjunction with the efforts and recognition that other countries and ethnic groups have received, such as Koreatown, Chinatown, and Japanese Town (Little Tokyo).
