**Comments for Public Posting:** Los Angeles Waterkeeper supports the wastewater recycling project at the Donald C. Tillman Water Reclamation Plant, which is a critical first step toward expanding our wastewater recycling capacity in the City. We are particularly pleased that the project will route additional sewage flow to Tillman to optimize recycling at the facility, without having to reduce the amount of wastewater discharged into the Los Angeles River, which serves vital functions for minimum flows in the dry season that supports habitat and wildlife. This project, and future recycling projects undertaken by the City, should be pursued through a holistic and regional approach that maximizes wastewater recycling as quickly as possible, while minimizing costs, impacts to the environment, and contributions to climate change.
