Councilmember John Lee,

To the Honorable Members of the City Council,

With the City facing financial crisis and billions wasted on ineffective homeless programs, it is clear that current leadership has lost credibility in responsibly managing public funds and policy.

I strongly urge you to rescind the City's "sanctuary" status for individuals who are in the country illegally and have committed crimes. Instead, it is time to prioritize the safety and wellbeing of law-abiding, taxpaying citizens.

Our communities deserve a sanctuary from the rampant crime, open-air drug markets, and widespread homelessness that have overtaken our neighborhoods. The current policies that permit thousands to live in squalor—on sidewalks and in parks, surrounded by human waste, used needles, and the stench of decay—are inhumane and unacceptable.

Crime is out of control. Robberies, arson, looting, and open drug dealing go unpunished. We've seen entire neighborhoods destroyed and thousands of homes lost to fires linked to encampments. Over 2,000 people die on our streets each year—often from overdose, violence, or neglect—under the very policies meant to "help" them.

It is time for real action. Follow the lead of other cities that have successfully:

- Banned homeless encampments in public areas,
- Prohibited open drug use and drug sales,
- Reinstated law enforcement's ability to uphold existing laws.

Our city cannot survive this ongoing neglect. Restore order. Restore public safety. Restore dignity to our communities.
