On May 10, 2024, the Energy and Environment Committee considered a City Administrative Officer report relative to authorizing the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) and Board of Public Works to prepare and submit grant application for the California Governor's Office of Planning and Research, Integrated Climate Adaptation and Resiliency Program, Extreme Heating and Community Resiliency Program Round 1, for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024.

After an opportunity for public comment was provided, the committee recommended that Council approve the recommendations, with a technical amendment read into the record by the Chair of the Energy and Environment Committee as follows:

1. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, RAP and the Director, Public Works (PW) Board, or designees to prepare and submit grant applications for the California Governor's Office of Planning and Research (OPR), Integrated Climate Adaptation and Resiliency Program (ICARP), Extreme Heating and Community Resiliency Program (EHCRP) Round 1– FY 2023-2024.
2. INSTRUCT the General Manager, RAP and the Director, PW Board, or designees, if the City is awarded the grants, to request authority to accept the grant awards and to request approval for any related actions to implement the grant awards.
