Comments for Public Posting: We are deeply concerned about the proposed cell tower that Verizon is planning to put at the corner of Argus and Colorado Blvd in our neighborhood of Eagle Rock, CA. Our biggest concern is the lack of process and oversight on this proposal. Verizon did not have the correct public hearing and therefore did not obtain the democratic consensus needed to put this project through. It is now public record that they knowingly avoided the proper procedures required for such a project, which reeks of duplicity, and as a result has led to distrust. We demand, fairly, that Verizon either start the approval process from the beginning, OR, abandon the project entirely, and find another location, as there are many other areas in the County of Los Angeles. Furthermore, the proposed design is a blight in an otherwise picturesque neighborhood, and is not inline with current community specific organizations like TERA, and the Colorado Blvd Specific Plan, which was never consulted on this matter. We consider the design a visual, and visceral, betrayal.
