

TRANSPORTATION and ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to the feasibility of enacting a City program to address local air quality challenges, and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker – Yaroslavsky):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), with the assistance of the Port of Los Angeles, Wilmington Neighborhood Council, and other important stakeholders, to report on the feasibility of enacting a program in Los Angeles, whether geographically focused or to be implemented citywide, similar to New York City's 2017 Citizens Air Complaint Program to address local air quality challenges.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 26, 2025, the Transportation Committee considered Motion (Hutt – Hernandez) relative to the feasibility of enacting a City program to address local air quality challenges. The Motion attached to the Council file includes some background on the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation in the Motion.

On March 4, 2025, the Energy and Environment Committee considered the matter and concurred with the action taken by the Transportation Committee on February 26, 2025. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
