

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the LA Organics Compliance Incentive Program for recycLA customers, and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the following LA Organic Compliance Incentive Program designed to support recycLA commercial and multifamily customers:

- a. Priority One Customers - Standalone restaurants in the recycLA program that have not subscribed to the organics program, as detailed in the April 19, 2024, Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) report, attached to the Council file.
- b. Priority Two Customers - Multifamily properties in the recycLA program that have not subscribed to the organics program, as detailed in the April 19, 2024, BOS report, attached to the Council file.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the BOS. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
