
Four related lawsuits¹ filed by various oil operators, lobbying groups, and petroleum royalty owners challenge the City's adoption of Ordinance No. 187,709, amending Los Angeles Municipal Code Sections 12.03, 12.20, 12.23, 12.24, and 13.01 to prohibit new oil and gas extraction and make existing oil extraction activities a nonconforming use in all zones.
