CPIO I am concerned about the South Los Angeles CPIO because we have been waiting for a year to hear from the City Attorney's office, we have requested a meeting with the city attorney and we have been ignored and then when we finally had a meeting set up by the city attorney, the city attorney canceled the meeting. We are upset with this behavior and lack of action. We want the South L.A. CPIO in place now because we want to ensure that tenants of south Los Angeles have as much protection as possible from displacement. We are here demanding that the South Los Angeles CPIO amendments get drafted immediately and voted on as soon as possible. It has been an entire year we need action on the South L.A. now. USC soccer stadium: As a community member I am concerned about the lack of community engagement for the USC women's soccer stadium. I live not so far from the proposed stadium and I have not seen any community meetings regarding the impact of this stadium on the neighborhood. Instead of a womens soccer stadium USC should focus on building student housing on USC owned land. The end: We are concerned that the expansion of USC and its increase in student enrollment will have a negative impact in our South Los Angeles community. To prevent a massive displacement of the community in South Los Angeles we are asking for 2 things Draft and pass the South L.A.
