

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. along both sides of Kentwood Avenue from W 80th Place to Manchester Avenue, Glasgow Place from 102nd Street to 104th Street, Grand View Boulevard from Palms Boulevard to Charnock Road, Federal Avenue from Wilshire Boulevard to Rochester Avenue.

SUBMITS WITHOUT RECOMMENDATION the recommendations of Resolution (Park - Lee):

RESOLVE to:

1. Prohibit, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.69.4, the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along both sides of the following street segments:
  - a. Kentwood Avenue from W 80th Place to Manchester Avenue
  - b. Glasgow Place from 102nd Street to 104th Street
  - c. Grand View Boulevard from Palms Boulevard to Charnock Road
  - d. Federal Avenue from Wilshire Boulevard to Rochester Avenue.
2. Direct the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon adoption of this Resolution, to post signs giving notice of a “tow away, no parking” restriction for oversize vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.
3. Authorize the LADOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On March 26, 2025, the Transportation Committee considered Resolution (Park - Lee) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. along both sides of Kentwood Avenue from W 80th Place to Manchester Avenue, Glasgow Place from 102nd Street to 104th Street, Grand View Boulevard from Palms Boulevard to Charnock Road, Federal Avenue from Wilshire Boulevard to Rochester Avenue. The report attached to the Council file includes some background on the matter.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to submit without recommendation. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
