

MOTION

Proposition 1 created a Statewide competitive grant program to reform and expand the behavioral health continuum of care and Council File 24-0580 authorizes the City Administrative Officer to coordinate with Council offices to solicit proposals and report on partnerships with the Council within 30 days with recommendations to apply for funding. The deadline to apply is December 13, 2024.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the General Services Department (GSD), with the assistance of the City Attorney, to negotiate a purchase and sale agreement with the owner(s) of real property located at 7631 Canoga Avenue (A.P.N. 2110017059) and 7630 Alabama Avenue (A.P.N. 2110017BRK), and report to the Council with the purchase price and other terms and conditions of the acquisition.

I FURTHER MOVE that the General Services Department be instructed to conduct all required due diligence including, but not limited to, a Class "A" appraisal of the properties selected.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst and the City Attorney, draft a memorandum of understanding with necessary entities to set terms for the acquisition and operation of the site.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering, with the assistance of GSD, CAO, and Los Angeles Housing Department to draft a conceptual site plan and other elements necessary to complete the submission of the Proposition 1 application.
