

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE, and RESOLUTION (PARK – LEE) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along certain street segments of McLaughlin Avenue and Campus Drive, in Council District (CD) 11.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Park – Lee):

RESOLVE to:

1. PROHIBIT, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along the following street segments:
 - a. Both sides of McLaughlin Avenue between Palms Boulevard and Westminster Avenue
 - b. Both sides of Campus Drive between Shared Drive and Bluff Creek Drive
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon adoption of this Resolution, to post signs giving notice of a “tow away, no parking” restriction for oversize vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On December 4, 2024, your Transportation Committee considered a Resolution (Park – Lee) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along certain street segments of McLaughlin Avenue and Campus Drive, in CD 11, as detailed in the Resolution and in Recommendation No. 1 above. According to the Resolution, there is an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking along several street segments in CD 11 where large vehicles are often parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations. Pursuant to LAMC Section 80.69.4, and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, it is proposed that the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., be prohibited along the street segments as detailed in Recommendation No. 1. After

consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommendation to approve the Resolution failed. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
