Comments for Public Posting: Homeless encampment located at Comercio, Clarendon and Alhama in Woodland Hills. The current situation of homeless individuals surrounding this 2 block area in Woodland Hills has become increasing worse and deemed by our employees and customers as extremely unsafe. We have loss of business and employees hesitant to come to work. We have had a vehicle stolen and another vandalized. An individual died by overdose weeks back and it was our employee that contacted 911 as the body lay next to our back lot for hours. Individuals are entering our place of business, taking food while running in and out, posing an extreme hazard to our customers and employees. Employees arrive to work with individuals on the streets not clothed, human fecal matter laying across the sidewalks, and mounds of trash that at this point seem mild due to the seriousness of the lack of safety in this area. This situation needs to be addressed before something catastrophic happens to an innocent citizen.
