TRANSPORTATION

On Saturday, April 26, 2025, a community cleanup event will take place in Hollywood as part of a City-wide effort that will bring together residents, city agencies, and partners to clean and beautify neighborhoods across Los Angeles. Volunteers will pick up loose litter, plant trees, remove graffiti and conduct other cleanup and beautification activities.

There is a City-owned parking lot located at 1627 N. Vine Street that can be used to accommodate parking for event volunteers. To cover the waiver of the fees, it is estimated that \$5,941 in costs will be incurred by the Special Parking Revenue Fund. Once the actual amount is determined, it will be reimbursed by the Mayor's Fund.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council AUTHORIZE the Department of Transportation (LADOT) to:

1. Suspend enforcement of parking from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 26, 2025 at Lot 702 (1627 N. Vine Street) to provide parking for volunteers participating in a community cleanup event in Hollywood.
2. Accept grant funding from Mayor's Fund to reimburse the Special Parking Revenue Fund for costs associated with the suspension of parking enforcement on Saturday, April 26, 2025 at Lot 702 (1627 N. Vine Street) to provide parking for volunteers participating in a community cleanup event in Hollywood.
3. Prepare Controller instructions to make any necessary technical corrections consistent with this action, subject to approval of the City Administrative Officer.

I FURTHER MOVE that should the date of the event change due to unforeseen circumstances, the aforementioned departmental instructions will apply.
