

CIVIL RIGHTS, EQUITY, IMMIGRATION AGING AND DISABILITY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to accepting funds from and executing Grant Agreement 22-1706-006 SF with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for the transition of the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program to the electronic benefit card system.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Soto-Martinez - Price), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Department of Aging to accept \$3,846 from the California Department of Food and Agriculture for the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program.
2. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Department of Aging, or designee, to execute the Grant Agreement (22-1706-006 SF) with the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
