

MOTION

On September 8, 2024, Paris concluded hosting the Olympic and Paralympic Games with a memorable closing ceremony at the Stade de France. Staging the 29 days of ceremonies and competitions of the 2024 Games required a high level of coordination between numerous city, federal, and international agencies; public advocacy groups; and over 45,000 volunteers.

Los Angeles will host the Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2028. Each City department will have an important part to play in the preparation and execution of these monumental events, from long-term planning to day-of service requests. In anticipation of the Games, City departments have been coordinating planning activities through the Office of the Mayor, Office of the Chief Legislative Analyst, and City Administrative Officer.

A number of City departments sent representatives to France to observe the activities and experience best practices that might aid preparation efforts for the 2028 Games. Now that Paris has handed the Olympic torch to Los Angeles, it is vital that the Council understand what these City representatives have learned during their time in Paris.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the City Administrative Officer, Emergency Management Department, Fire Department, Police Department, Los Angeles World Airports, Department of Cultural Affairs, Department of Disability, Department of Public Works – Bureau of Engineering, Department of Public Works – Bureau of Street Services, Department of Recreation and Parks, Department of Transportation, and the Department of Water and Power to report on observations, findings, and best practices gathered from the 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games in Paris.
