The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$75,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the act of murder against, BRENDA AGUILERA AND JONATHAN PLASCENCIA, in the City of Los Angeles. On Sunday, April 27, 2008, at approximately 10:45 p.m., officers responded to a shooting involving multiple victims at 48th Street and Wall Street in the Newton Area of Los Angeles. Police believe that the suspect, who is described as a male Hispanic, walked up to a vehicle and began shooting. Inside the vehicle were 21-year old Brenda Aguilera and 20-year old Jonathan Plascencia, who both ultimately died as a result of their wounds. As the suspect fled on foot, he fired additional rounds that wounded three other victims. Those victims were expected to survive. Detectives are asking for the public's help to identify the person responsible for these fatal shootings. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, APRIL 15, 2017.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. Cuando el sospechoso huyó a pie, disparó rondas adicionales que hirieron a otras tres víctimas. Se espera que estas víctimas sobrevivan. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. 
