

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of establishing a dedicated speed hump program for elementary schools.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Krekorian – Hutt – Hernandez):

1. APPROVE the LADOT’s proposed plan to implement speed humps on 100 street segments at the Top 50 schools identified by the Safe Routes to School strategic plan in Fiscal year 2023-2024.
2. DIRECT the LADOT to report in 90 days with recommendations to prioritize additional schools in future fiscal years, including any additional staff and resources required to continue the annual school speed hump program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The LADOT reports that \$2,000,000 is allocated in the 2023-24 Proposed Budget for the purpose of a dedicated Speed Hump and Speed Table Program for Schools. No additional funding is being requested at this time.

SUMMARY:

At its regular meeting held on June 28, 2023, the Transportation Committee considered a LADOT report relative to a response to Motion (Krekorian – Hutt – Hernandez) on the feasibility of establishing a dedicated speed hump program for elementary schools. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee engaged in discussion on the subject. The discussion led to an amendment by Councilmember Raman to amend recommendation two from reporting back in one year to a shorter time frame of 90 days at the department’s concurrence. The committee then moved to approve as amended the recommendations in the report, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
