We are appreciative of the leadership the City has take to prioritize public health, climate and equity and leading and environmental champion by advancing decarbonization efforts. We are thrilled to have LA City pass a resolution in support of South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD)rules 1111 and 1121 which will set zero-emission standards for space and water heating in our homes and getting polluting gas out of our buildings and homes. SCAQMD, whose responsibility is to regulate appliances and equipment by setting standards, has a big opportunity to ensure that gas-polluting space and water heating is phased out in the upcoming years. The best part of these rules is that there is a rebate program, GoZero program, where there is a commitment to invest the majority of this funding to assist the transition to low-income community members, train up the word force, and educate community about this and how to stack other incentives.
