Subject: RESOLUTION NO. 23-10249 – APPROVAL OF SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 17-3463 BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES HARBOR DEPARTMENT AND TY LIN INTERNATIONAL FOR THE ENGINEERING, ARCHITECTURAL, AND LANDSCAPING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE AVALON PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND PROMENADE GATEWAY PROJECT

Pursuant to Section 373 of the City Charter and Section 10.5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 23-10249 authorizing approval of the proposed Second Amendment to Agreement No. 17-3463 between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and TY Lin International, of Los Angeles, California, to continue providing project management, planning, engineering, architectural design, landscape design, design support during bidding and construction and project closeout for the Avalon Pedestrian Bridge and Promenade Gateway Project. The proposed second Amendment will extend the Agreement by four years and ten months for a total term of eleven years and ten months and increase the Compensation by \$1,700,000 to a new not-to-exceed total of \$3,889,375. The second Amendment is required because of increased costs due to delays in design, property transfer, and expanded scope of services. The Harbor Department will continue to be financially responsible for the payment of expenses incurred under the Agreement. There is no impact to the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

- 1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the proposed action is administratively exempt and has been previously evaluated pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article II Sections 2(f) and 2(i) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; and
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 23-10249 authorizing approval of the Second Amendment to Agreement No. 23-3463-B with TY Lin International.
