

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City’s position regarding legislative or administrative action that would counter the effects of the Supreme Court case decisions in *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc., v. President and Fellows of Harvard College*, and *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v. University of North Carolina. et al.*, and restore affirmative action protections.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Harris-Dawson – Raman), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include the City’s 2023-24 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for legislative or administrative action that would counter the effects of the Supreme Court case decisions in *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc., v. President and Fellows of Harvard College*, and *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v. University of North Carolina. et al.*, and restore affirmative action protections.

SUMMARY
