**Comments for Public Posting:** March 28, 2025 Re: CF#25-0600-S1 / S2 / S3 / S12 / S18 / S21 / S24 Budget Proposal Fiscal Year 2025-26 Annual Budget Resolution for Fiscal Year 2025-26 CIS - LAPD Northeast Division Community Police Advisory Board The Los Angeles Police Department Community Police Advisory Board (C-PAB) Northeast Division supports the LA City Council in approving a 2025-26 FY Budget and strongly urges City Council to reconsider any drastic reductions to LAPD Civilian-support Staffing, Recruitment, Operations/Crisis Team Prevention/Intervention Programs or any further reductions in 911 Dispatch “response times and accountability” that tangibly affect LAPD’s efforts to “Protect and to Serve.” Mayor Karen Bass’s promise of 9,500+ officers with the current budget’s allowance of roughly 9,300 officers and further reductions being considered in the 2025-26 FY budget falls far below Angeleno’s expectations, which will significantly affect the challenges LAPD faces for effectively policing our Neighborhoods and Communities Citywide. Per capita, LAPD’s coverage is 2.2 officers per 1,000 Residents - significantly less than the per-capita coverage of New York and Chicago. Equally, LAPD’s 16.7 p/sq mile coverage falls far behind NYPD’s 119.2 and CPD’s 51.3 cap p/sq mile already over-extending LAPD’s efforts to ensure efficient response times, public safety, crime prevention and intervention programming services. Community-Policing Constituencies in Council District 1, 4, 13 and 14 strongly encourage the City Council and Mayor Bass’ Office to remove wasteful budget policies and programs (i.e. \$1M+ legal immigration services, homelessness initiatives and other "bloated spending" measures, etc) and appropriately allocate the necessary funds for community-enhanced policing, gang intervention/prevention programs and LAPD recruitment and hiring. The LAPD C-PAB Northeast Division is a proponent of all public safety measures that benefit our Northeast LA Communities of Atwater Village, Cypress Park, Eagle Rock, East Hollywood, Echo Park, Elysian Valley-Elysian Park, Franklin Hills, Garvanza, Glassell Park, Griffith Park, Highland Park, Los Feliz/Franklin Hills, Los Feliz Village, and Mt.
