Comments for Public Posting: I write in memory of P-22 mountain lion and with respect to the indigenous watershed, air, land known as Tovaangar. This not only aligns with our environmental objectives but also addresses the broader nexus of SPATIAL JUSTICE. How to implement AB-2147 and AB-1909: Remove "No Pedestrian" Signs: Removing all "No Pedestrian" signs, allowing pedestrians to cross anywhere deemed safe, including mid-block. Ensure Crosswalks on All Intersections: Install crosswalks on all legs of intersections for maximum safety, complying with regulations that prohibit pedestrians from crossing on specific legs. Motorist Education Campaign for Cyclists: Launch a public education campaign to inform motorists about their responsibility to use a full lane (when available) when passing cyclists and to maintain a minimum distance of 3 feet at all times.
