Comments for Public Posting: I live on Bentley Avenue quite near where Bentley turns into Brookhaven Avenue, and I use that walkway pretty frequently. If the walkway were permanently closed off, my walks to stores on National Boulevard would be considerably longer, and there would be difficulties imposed upon dwellers in the apartment building on Sepulveda Boulevard adjoining the walkway. Their trash dumpster is accessed for emptying from Bentley Avenue, but their stairway is west of that dumpster. I cannot see feasibility of locating a permanent closure of the walkway working out for those folks, who need access to their dumpster from the west, yet the disposal company needs access from the east. I'd like to suggest that closure of that walkway being made by some sort of sturdy, self-locking gate to which residents, both of that apartment building and of single-family houses on the 2600 block of Bentley Avenue, can be provided with a key.
