

AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR LA RECOVERY REPORT relative to issuing additional parking permits to residents in preferential parking districts who are currently sheltering people displaced by the Palisades or Eaton fires.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Park - Hutt):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to take the necessary steps to issue up to two additional annual and up to two additional visitor parking permits (for a maximum total of four additional permits), to residents in preferential parking districts who are currently sheltering people displaced by the Palisades or Eaton fires; residents must provide proof of residency in an area that was subject to a mandatory evacuation order that began January 7, 2025 or thereafter; and the permits will be effective until January 7, 2026.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on February 6, 2025, your Ad Hoc Committee for LA Recovery considered a Motion (Park - Hutt) relative to issuing additional parking permits to residents in preferential parking districts who are currently sheltering people displaced by the Palisades or Eaton fires.
