**Re: CF 25-0006-S38 (Park/Nazarian): report back on creation of Climate Resiliency District for Areas Impacted by the Palisades Fire -- SUPPORT**

Dear President Harris-Dawson, Councilwoman Park, Councilmember Nazarian, and all other Members of the Los Angeles City Council:

Founded in 1973, Pacific Palisades Community Council (PPCC) is the most broad-based community organization and voice of Pacific Palisades.

Our community has suffered the worst catastrophe in the City's history, resulting in devastation and immense suffering for Palisades residents and businesses. As a result, at our regularly scheduled public Board meeting on February 27, 2025, on the recommendation of the PPCC Land Use Committee and after full discussion, the PPCC board unanimously passed the following motion:

*"Pacific Palisades Community Council (PPCC) has been the voice of the Palisades community for 52 years. Although devastated by the catastrophic Palisades Fire, our beloved community is strong and is determined to rise again. PPCC accordingly supports Council File 25-0006-S38, which calls for a report back on creation of a Climate Resilience District for the directly impacted and adjacent areas of the Pacific Palisades Fire, as an important tool to assist in achieving our community's goal of rebuilding the Palisades."*<sup>1</sup>

We urge the City Council to adopt the motion in the above-referenced Council File at the earliest opportunity, so that the requested report on creation of a Climate Resilience District for impacted areas of Pacific Palisades can be initiated without delay. Thank you for your consideration and anticipated support for this important Council File.
