Street vending contributes to the culinary and cultural fabric of the City of Los Angeles, and often is the entrepreneurial first step towards a brick and mortar business. After years of debate, on September 17, 2018, Governor Jerry Brown signed Senate Bill 946, which is also known as the Safe Sidewalk Vending Act. This law decriminalized sidewalk vending in California and allowed the City to establish the rules and regulations on how, when and where a street vendor can operate.


Council District 1 is committed to a multi-prong approach (education, infrastructure, business assistance) to supporting street vendors, especially vendors who are struggling to economically survive and grow their businesses.

Recognizing the importance and requirements of certain permits, Council District 1 is working with vendors and Bureau of Street Services to provide permit education and financial assistance.

**I THEREFORE MOVE** that \$20,000 in the Council District 1 portion of the Neighborhood Service Enhancements line item in the General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56 Account No. 579 be transferred to Bureau of Street Services- Fund 100, Department No. 86, 003040 Contractual Services Account for Sidewalk Vending education and outreach in Council District 1.

**I FURTHER MOVE** that the Bureau of Street Services be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections/clarifications/changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
