HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Comprehensive Homeless Strategy (CHS) enhancement and timeframe.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. APPROVE the proposed new framework for the CHS, as detailed in the City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated August 27, 2018, attached to the Council file.
- 2. INSTRUCT the Homeless Coordinator to report to the Homeless Strategy Committee in 45 days with the enhanced CHS, including the following:
 - a. Consideration of other areas of intense concentration in the City, including Venice.
 - b. Accountability for sub-populations strategies.
 - c. Incorporation of annual goals and not just accomplished metrics.
 - d. Conduct robust outreach to all stakeholders including the homeless community.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on September 5, 2018, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered a CAO report regarding recommendations for the CHS enhancement and timeframe. Staff from the CAO and the City Homeless Coordinator provided the Committee an overview of the report. Councilmember Huizar commented about going beyond the status quo and the typical norm, and to evaluate over-concentration strategies. Councilmember Bonin asked in the report back, to consider other areas of intense concentration, have accountability for sub-populations, have annual goals, and to obtain input from people on the street. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendations in the CAO report, along with the recommendations from the Committee members. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
